Safeguarding Policy

1. Policy

1.1. General Statement

1.2. Orchard Vale Trust will take reasonable steps to ensure residents, staff and visitors are as safe as they can be and that risks are managed. Residents are protected from abuse, or the risk of abuse and their human rights are respected and upheld.

2. Procedures

2.1. Taking Action

2.1.1. We will take steps to prevent abuse and will not tolerate any abusive practice should it occur. Action will immediately be taken to ensure that any abuse identified is stopped and suspected abuse is addressed.

2.2. Working with others

2.2.1. We will work collaboratively with others in relation to all safeguarding matters and has safeguarding policies that link with local authority policies, both with Somerset and Banes. We will follow the referral process and timescales as described in all relevant local and national multi-agency procedures when responding to suspected abuse.

2.3. Best Interests

2.3.1. We will only request authorisation under the Mental Capacity Act 2005 Deprivation of liberty safeguards, when it is in the best interests of the resident and the resident lacks capacity.

2.4. Training

2.4.1. Safeguarding training is an integral part of an effective safeguarding policy. All staff will complete Red Crier Safeguarding Training.
